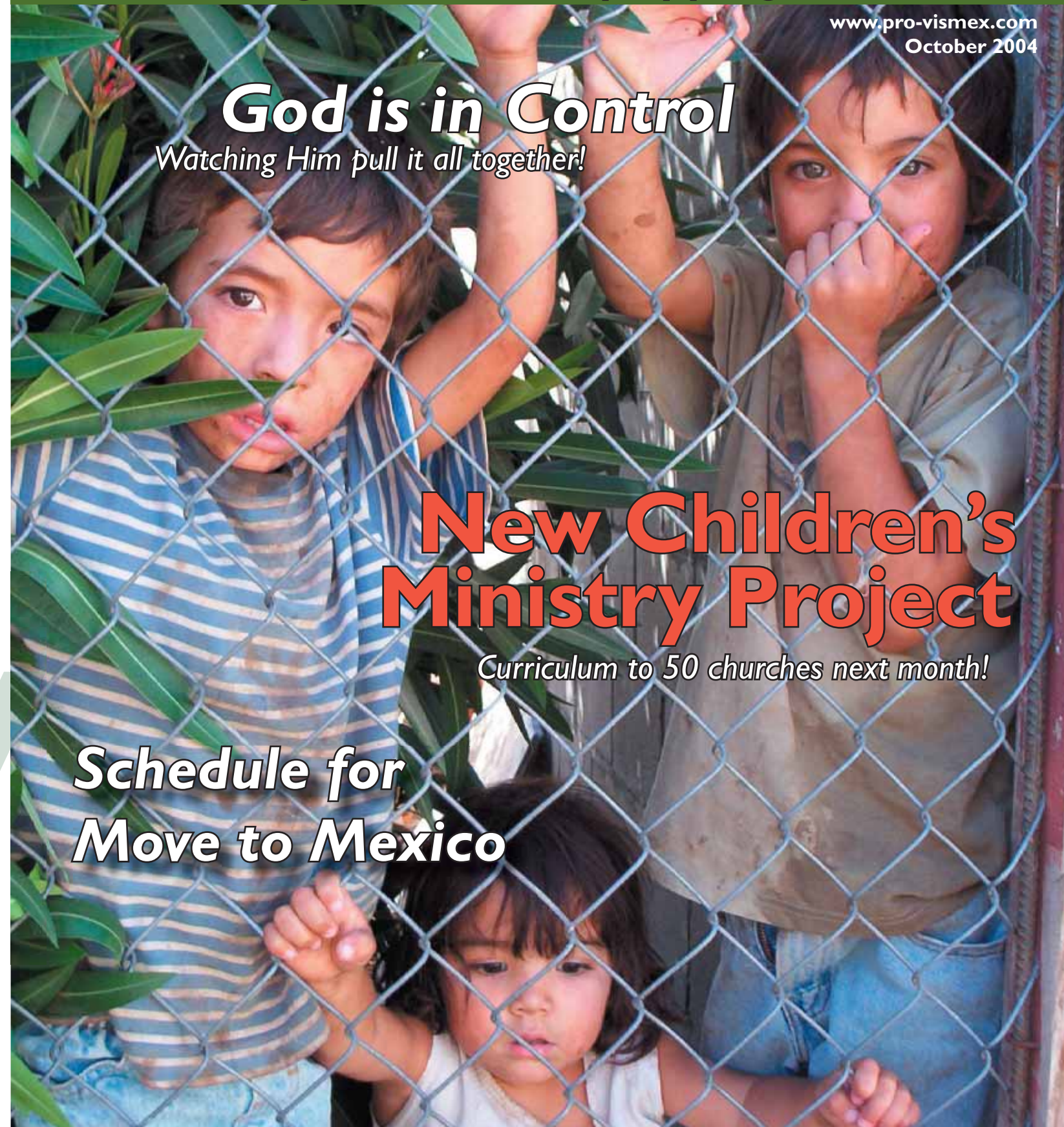

We went to Mexico in search of land, and found a perfect spot where we can buy as much as we want of 40 acres. We started raising funds for the land, and people started to give: we now have \$10,000 for the land! We started working on designing the ministry center and the initial construction plans, and God started to pull the team together for that too! We are getting professional design help and we have several teams interested in trips to Huatabampo to help us build. Here we are, one year later, setting aside a weekend this month to plan for the upcoming ministry. God is so good, and we are glad He is allowing us to be a part of this ministry!

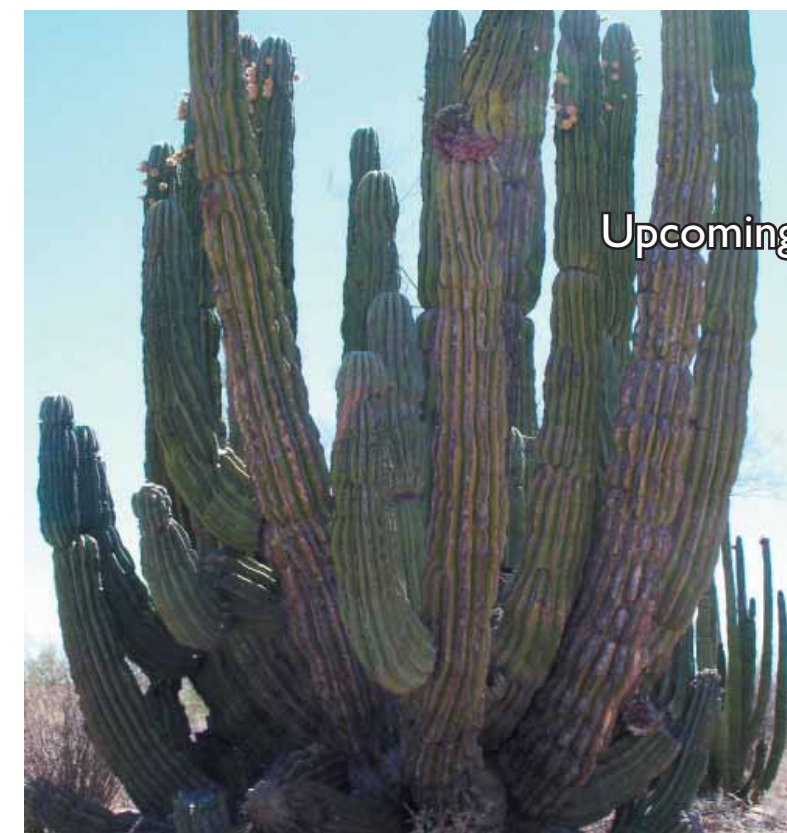

## Sunday School Curriculum and Supplies Project

A team is currently putting together a packet of Sunday School ministry ideas to equip workers in Mexico. In November, we are bringing to the Huatabampo area Sunday School curriculum, craft ministry supplies, craft and game ideas, worship music, songsheets, and training for 50 churches!
