Another great month! Our communications situation is getting better, we are in our house, the office is nearing completion, weather is great, we had some great ministry and Pro-Vision has grown by one! We have a lot of visitors, and we are able to help nearly all of them in some tangible way. We were going to halt construction but realized it would be better to keep going and, presto, two weeks later we have walls of public restrooms.

This month, we look forward to completing our home, finishing the bathrooms, getting the office organized, setting up our color plotter as well as some great ministry. We are excited about Bob Firebaugh coming to present some serious Bible Study techniques to pastors and lay leaders as well as Criss Firebaugh returning for more teaching on effective children's ministry.

God has so richly blessed us and this ministry. We have seen great growth this last year, starting from nothing and we fully expect to see it continue. Thank you so much for being part of the Pro-Vision team!

What's NEW?

1. The physical plant continues to grow. Two guys, two weeks, and we have walls up for a couple of nice two holer baños. This will take a lot of load off of our home as we have a lot of visitors and it will be great for events.

2. We are excited to introduce Lupita Ayalla to you, our first paid ministry staff member. She helps with the office and ministry projects. You may have seen her before, we met her over three years ago and she has been helping us almost since we got here. Both she and her husband Marcos are ministry-minded, creative, well read and posses other qualities required for the job. They have pastored for over 7 years, and currently

4. Our office and print shop continues to be a blessing to many. Here is a small print job we are able to do for a local church, 200 copies of a 102 page training on home groups and discipleship. We charge our direct cost, which is about 20% of what the copy shop would charge. This gets good materials out that would otherwise be unavailable.

5. The day before Valentines day, we hosted as group of 20 pastors and their wives in our new office for breakfast, fellowship

and a little teaching. We began with a pancake breakfast. (Mexicans don't know quite what to do with pancakes) Followed by Dwight teaching about keeping a happy spouse from Gary Chapman's book "The Five Love Languages." At the end, each pastor got a copy of the book and a special 8x10 photo of his and his wife which we were able to print on the spot. Apparently they liked what they heard as we got invited to share the teaching in two other churches. (Our decorations also went out to two other church banquets)
