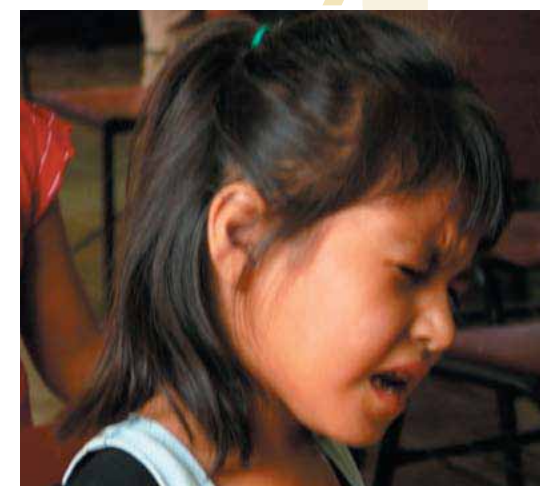

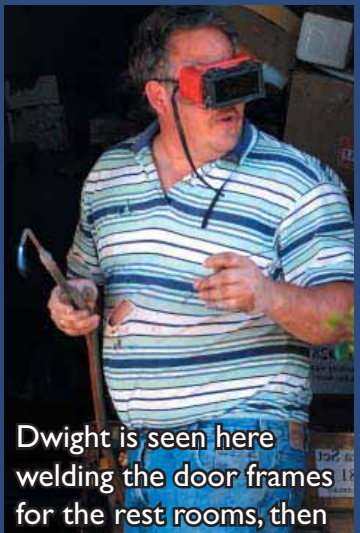

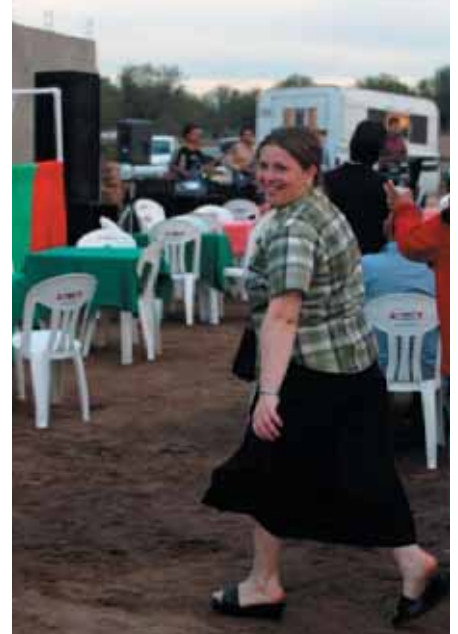


### Pastors Conference
